

The Wandering Walls

On an ocean front mountain top between tall grasses and acacia forests, rugged curvaceous walls blur the boundaries between architecture and landscape to define public and private spaces of an eight room retreat. The retreat, thus named Wandering Walls, is a building where the walls 'wander' throughout like flowing ribbons. Inspired by the raw beauty of the natural surroundings, the design concept seeks to create a sense of quietude and permanence with a single architectural element and a minimal palette of materials; defining the entire architecture with just curves walls that are both structure and form, inside and outside, exterior and interior all at once. On the roof is a 360 degree infinity pool with sweeping panoramic views of the ocean and the surrounding mountains.
